

Flower and Plant Care Tips

Floral Arrangements

- Keep the vase filled (or floral foam soaked) with water containing a flower food. Flower foods make flowers last longer. Follow the mixing directions on the flower food packet. If the water becomes cloudy, replace it entirely with properly mixed flower food solution.
- Re-cut stems by removing one to two inches with a sharp knife.
- Keep flowers in a cool spot (65 to 72 degrees Fahrenheit), away from direct sunlight, heating or cooling vents, directly under ceiling fans, or on top of televisions or radiators.

House Plants

- Keep plants in medium-light locations out of direct sunlight. Most flowering potted plants do well in areas with lots of light. Foliage plants do well under lower light levels.
- Plant soil should be kept moist at all times.
 Avoid overwatering do not allow plants to stand in water. Avoid wetting plant leaves.
- Avoid excessive heat or cold. Plants should be kept in a cool spot (between 65 to 72 degrees Fahrenheit) for best performance. They should be kept away from direct sunlight, heating or cooling vents, directly under ceiling fans, or on top of televisions or radiators.
